There are always vehicles parking on paths down by the corner shop.</p> <p>Reply from Andrew Prigmore, Manager for Traffic Operations. 'It is not an offence to park on a verge or footway. It is however an offence to cause an obstruction and it is the police who have powers to take enforcement action.</p> <p>As there are no parking restrictions in this area, we cannot take action in this matter. We could look at installing a no verge / footway parking restriction in this road in a future programme of work if this is something that the Parish Council would like us to pursue. However at this time, we do not have a budget for such a restriction.'</p> |
